Zero Emissions Grant Application - Leigh

Been submitted, Leigh's hard work, thanks to all for contributions, extremely helpful. It will possibly be 2 months before we see anything. What will we do over the next 2 months? Possibly the lighting. Leigh suggested going straight to complete LED batons, 1.2m long x 6 units. We need to find another electrician. Initially the shed needed only windows, but now need door and windows. The floor will come up with the insulation, and so we cannot put the door in until this occurs, otherwise there will be a step. Need also to consider budget. Total in account is around \$7,000.

Volunteer/s for Super Shed display

Using Harley's slides, low energy super shed slides, LESS slides, Images of Passive Houses, create a display using coreflute and images. Also ask Harley for a wall section sample. Having a permanent display set up, relieves us from having to be physically present and if we are there, then we can use this information to

support our presentation. Phil will take coreflute to set up display.

Volunteer/s photographs and website updates

Supershed on website needs images. Shed being used by Southern Harvest to distribute vegetables, every Thursday evening, 4 – 6pm.
